### COURSE DESCRIPTION

Equine Dental Diagnostics Upgrade is a course designed to hone a practitioner's oral examination and dental radiographs skills utilizing the newest technology.

This course focuses on arming veterinarians with a deeper understanding of oral and dental anatomy, common pathology, examination techniques, radiographic acquisition, and radiographic interpretation.

Oral examination will be taught with the newest equipment for oral and dental endoscopy. Both intraoral and extraoral radiographic techniques will be taught using the most state-of-the-art imaging systems.

After performing oral exams and acquiring radiographs, radiographic interpretation and treatment will be discussed and practiced in small groups to maximize learning.

Veterinarians will leave the course with the knowledge to either start or build their dental practice.
